Description:

The goal of this seminar is to introduce students to current research topics in the fields of applied macroeconomics. Students will work on one current research paper (to be selected from the list of papers below) and are expected to prepare a presentation and to write a seminar paper about it. Methodologies covered include conventional econometric methods such as VAR analyses, panel estimations but also new approaches using techniques from the area of data science.

Seminar requirements:

Students will be graded upon the following:

- Presentation: (40%).
- Seminar thesis: (60%).

In order to successfully pass the seminar each of the two seminar requirements have to be graded with at least 4.0.
