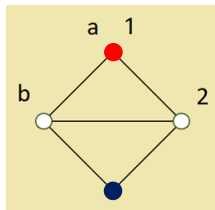


There are a number of variants of the board game *Chinese Checkers*. Simple ones are suitable for approaching the basics of game theory.

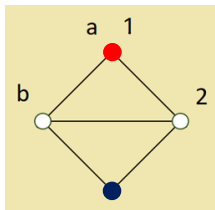
- The picture below shows the board of a trivial simplification of *Chinese Checkers*
