## **Information on seminar papers and theses**

You have the possibility to write your bachelor or master thesis at our chair. There are currently 8 places available for bachelor and master theses per semester.

In the following you will find more information about the application procedure and the process.

### **Bachelor or master theses**

- If you are interested in writing your thesis at our professorship, we look forward to receiving your application by mail or in person. Places are allocated according to both receipt and quality of the application/topic. Tip: Apply early and with a well thought-out idea. - **Application**  
Your application, indicating the desired start date, must include:
  - o Complete contact details (incl. telephone number and email address)
  - o 1-2 page exposé on the topic including a short problem definition, objective, approach and rough outline (see guidelines on our homepage)
  - o Overview of previous academic achievements (issued by the examination office)
- **Requirements**
  - o You take part in the "Exercise for the preparation of scientific papers" in the semester in question. If you have already participated in this exercise in a previous semester, participation is not obligatory, but nevertheless recommended. (Duration: 4 VL hours).
  - o In the semester in question, you will complete our "Bachelor's/Master's Thesis Colloquium". This is a course with a total of 3 dates for which attendance is compulsory. You can find out the dates of the current and upcoming semester on Unisono and on our homepage. At each of these dates, you will present the current status of your paper, discuss it with us/your fellow students, get feedback and tips for your further work and can clarify open questions. You will receive instructions on how to prepare for the respective event in advance.
