Thesis Topics

Global disruptions include public health (for example, pandemics - Asian flu, SARS, COVID-19), geopolitics (for example, Ukraine crisis, regime changes - both electoral and coups, populist policy changes, wars, terrorism), as well as technological change (for example, the rise of social media, 3-D printing, AI), and many other topics. These disruptions have a significant impact on entrepreneurship in general and on the way SMEs operate. Topics such as psychological factors in entrepreneurship and hybrid forms of business are also increasingly coming to the scientific spotlight.
